## **Volunteer Checklist**

1	Contact the middle school Principal and let them know about our free program and how much we appreciate them and the work they do and are excited to provide this FREE to their 8th grade teachers and students to honor Constitution Day. (We can send you the info for your school by emailing <a href="mailto:martha@917society.org">martha@917society.org</a> .
2	Most are not aware there is a Constitution Day and also a federal mandate (108-447) that all schools receiving federal funds are to honor this day on or near September 17th, if school is not in session that day. You can share the email we sent to them in case they did not open it by <u>clicking here</u> .
3	Make sure they know that the 917 Society is a non-partisan educational organization dedicated to honoring Constitution Day in our 8th grade classroom across America and is now in all 50 states and has approval of State Boards of Education as a free resource. There is no commentary or advertising in the material, only The Declaration of Independence, The Constitution and Amendments and the Oath of Citizenship.

5	We include instruction cards for teachers on how to access the free lesson plans, games and videos on our website.
